
CELEBRATING 20 YEARS!

2020 marks the Afterschool Alliance's 20th anniversary and as the leading voice for afterschool programs, we're especially proud of all we've accomplished. We're celebrating our partners, reflecting on the progress we've made, and looking ahead to ensure that all kids who want an afterschool program have the opportunity.

The number of youth in afterschool programs has almost doubled, and demand for programs has kept growing.



21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) funding for afterschool and summer programs has expanded to serve more children and families, despite repeated attempts to eliminate the program.

21st CCLC funds, supporting afterschool and summer programs in low-income communities, grew 176%.


